How the Program Works

The 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten program is a fun, exciting, and free way to prepare your child for learning to read.

1. **Who can join:** Children ages birth to five years (and not yet in Kindergarten).
2. **Register online:** www.wethersfieldlibrary.org/1000-books
3. **Visit the library:** Pick up your welcome packet, crayons and reading log.
4. **Track your reading online:** Record the titles of the books you have read on your online account. Any books count including: books you read more than once, books read at storytime, preschool, daycare, etc. as long as your child listens to the entire book, it counts!
5. **100-Book Milestones:** Each time you read 100 books, visit the library to receive a sticker and a new reading log.

Rewards

Registration: Welcome packet & crayons
100 Books: Bunny stuffed animal & sticker
200-400 Books: Sticker for each 100 books read.
500 Books: Book Bag & sticker
600-900 Books: Sticker for each 100 books read.
1,000 Books: Book of your choice, sticker & certificate.

How Can You Get to 1,000 Books?

1 bedtime story every night for 3 years
10 books a week for 2 years
20 books a week for 1 year (only 3 per day)
